
Name of the e-tender: e-tender for supply of 3,12,000 doses of sex sorted semen in phase manner during the year 2020-21.

The bid shall be submitted in 2 (Two) parts , posy registration in <http://tripuratenders.gov.in> as follows

General Specifications applicable to all sex-sorted semen straws:

Frozen sex sorted semen doses of various breeds to be supplied with following specifications:

SL. NO.	CRITERIA/PARTICULARS	SPECIFICATIONS
1.	Semen doses supplied	Should be Sex Sorted.
2.	Purity of Primary gender/ Gender Skew	Minimum 90% skew towards 'X' (Should be supported with appropriate laboratory test report).
3.	Sperm Concentration	Not less than 2.1 Million sperm per dose.
4.	Packing	Packed in 0.25 ml French mini straws with low absorbance in Goblets with 10 straws each
5.	Post thaw motility	Progressive motility of minimum 50% at 0 hr and 30% at 3 hr post thaw incubation
6.	Intact Acrosomes	Greater than or equal to 50 i.e. minimum 50% Sperm should be with intact acrosome.
7.	Field Conception rates across herds	Not less than 92% of the conventional semen under similar condition
8.	The bacterial load	Shall not be more than 5000 CFU per ml
9.	Standards and sanitary protocol	The guidelines of Govt of India with respect to Minimum Standards and Sanitary protocol (MSSP) will have to be followed. If there are no instructions for a particular parameter / character, the Instructors/guidelines of OIE will prevail
10.	Transportation	Under LN2 in suitable cryogenic containers used normally for transportation of any other bovine frozen semen
11.	Quality Control Report	Bull wise quality control report mentioning gender skew, concentration, post thaw motility and intact acrosome for each batch should be provided with the supply of sex sorted semen.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The contract shall remain effective up to 36 months after the date of issuance.
2. The tenderer has to specify the name of the manufacturer and name of the items, which are to be supplied.
Minimum Operational Standard Protocol (MOSP) for maintaining quality control in sex sorted semen production is to be enclosed with the tender documents.
3. Being a biological product, the order schedule will be shared in advance with the supplier for effective arrangement of logistics.
4. The firm will have to make the supplies within 15 days of the issuance of supply orders
5. The tenderer will have to offer at least 10,000 doses of sexed semen per bull and a minimum of 2 bulls in each breed. However, this will not restrict the right of the board to order any number of semen doses from any specific bull.
6. The minimum general female: male calf ratio must be 90:10. Zero payment will be made for entire batch for not achieving the minimum general male: female calf ratio as per gender skew test QC report.
7. Rates should be quoted destination basis up to Central Semen Collection Station, R.K.nagar Farm Complex, West Tripura, PIN-799008 and shall include all taxes, duties and other charges.
8. Conditional Tenders will be rejected out rightly.
9. The technical committee of TLDA will scrutinize the Technical & financial bids and comparative statement on rates quoted would be prepared for selection of lowest bidder. No advance payments will be made.
10. Sexed semen should preferably be made by sorting and separation rather than sorting and laser killing of sperm with Y chromosome.
11. The bidder will submit the sire directory and the semen of the bull having the highest dam's milk yield will be accepted.
12. The e-tender will be submitted addressed to the chief Executive officer, Tripura livestock Development Agency, Astabal, Agartala on or before **16/03/2020 till 5.00 P.M.** Tender received after aforesaid date and time shall be rejected. The chief Executive Officer, Tripura Livestock Development Agency (TLDA) shall not be responsible for any kind of delay.
13. A duly signed copy of the Terms & Condition of the DNIT should be returned by the tenderers as token of acceptance of the departmental terms & condition to the Chief Executive Officer, Tripura Livestock Development Agency, Astabal, Agartala, West Tripura, State Pin - 799001.
14. The tenderers/bidders are requested to provide details of address along with the phone/Fax number & STD code for communication, along with enquiry Number, date, due date of opening and address of the bidder as per e-tender format .
15. The bidder shall have to deposit an amount of **Rs. 25,00,000/-** (Rupees Twenty five lakh) only as **Earnest Money** for the item through **ONLINE Banking**. Registered Co-operative(s)/Societies and State/Central units permanently registered with NSIC are exempted from Earnest money if an authentic documentary proof is provided.
16. The successful bidder shall have to submit Bank document in prescribed format (Nationalized Bank) as security money of 5% of the tender value **Rs. 1,48,20,000/-** (Rupees One crore forty eight lakh twenty thousand) only in favour of the CEO, TLDA. **performance bank guarantee .**
